DJ WILD STUD POKER

DJ Wild Stud Poker features heads-up play against the dealer and the optional Trips Side Bet. The game is played with a standard 52-card deck, plus one Joker. The Joker and Deuces (Two's) are Wild. Best 5-card hand wins.

GETTING STARTED

Make equal bets in the ante and blind circles. You may also make an optional trips bonus bet and/or two-way bad beat bonus. You will then receive 5 cards.

MAKING YOUR DECISION

You can either elect to play against the dealer or fold your hand. If you play against the dealer, you will place a play wager in the amount of 2X your ante.

WINNING & LOSING

The dealer then reveals their 5-card hand and announces the hand. If your hand beats the dealer's, your play and ante bets win even money. If the dealer's hand beats yours, your ante, blind and play wagers lose. If you tie, those bets push. The blind pays if your winning hand is at least a three of a kind (see layout for odds). If you beat the dealer with less than a three-of-a-kind, the blind bet pushes.

TWO-WAY BAD BEAT

Player wins if both the player and the dealer each have three of a kind or better, and they do not tie. Players place their two-way bad-beat wagers in the marked circle. If the player's hand qualifies for payouts, the dealer pays them according to the posted pay table. If the player's hand does not qualify, the dealer takes the losing wager and moves on to the next player. If the dealer and the player have a five-card tie; then the Bad Beat Bonus bet loses because neither the dealer nor the player suffered a Bad Beat.

This Progressive is linked to your favorite Poker games: Three Card Poker, Four Card Poker, Let It Ride, Ultimate Texas Hold'em and DJ Wild Stud Poker! In DJ Wild Stud Poker, you would use your five cards for the Five Card Progressive Wager. If your hand contains the Joker, the additional progressive card dealt on the table will be used as your fifth card. If you have one of the hands in the pay table, you will win the prize indicated. If you bet on the Progressive and another player hits one of the TOP 2 Hands, you will receive an Envy Bonus.
