

DOUBLE DOWN MADNESS BLACKJACK



Introducing Double Down Madness™ Blackjack, the ultimate blackjack experience. Double Down Madness™ Blackjack offers a unique twist to the traditional game of blackjack. Each player receives one card initially and has the freedom to hit and double down as desired to significantly boost payouts. Double Down Madness™ Blackjack also offers the optional PUSH 22™ bonus wagers. No splitting or surrender is allowed, and the Dealer hits soft 17. The object is to draw cards that add up to 21 or as close to it as possible without going over. All cards have the same point value as in conventional blackjack.

HOW TO PLAY

Place your wager in the betting circle, you may also place an option PUSH 22 bonus wager. Once all wagers have been made, the Dealer will deal themselves the first card, then gives each Player one card face up. Finally, the Dealer takes their 2nd card face down and places their initial card face up on top. If the Dealer has a possible blackjack (10 or ace face up), then he shall peek at the hole card for a blackjack. If the Dealer has a blackjack, they will expose it before the players have a chance to act. All players' bets will lose against a Dealer blackjack, including if the player has a 10 or ace. Insurance is offered if the dealer's up card is an ace. If the Dealer has blackjack, all wagers lose, and no second card is dealt.

DECISIONS

Players have three choices to make after initial cards have been dealt:

1. Stand: maintain the current hand value.
2. Hit: request an additional card.
3. Double Down: double the initial/previous wager(s).

HITTING & DOUBLING DOWN

You may hit or double down with each card you receive until you decide to stand or your hand busts. When doubling down, you can match up to the amount already in play for the chance to maximize your blackjack payouts.

If the player doubles with only an ace, they will only receive one additional card only. Otherwise, the player may double at any time with any number of cards.

After the player doubles, they may continue making decisions, including standing, hitting and re-doubling. The player may double at any time. Doubling is allowed on three or more cards. When "re-doubling", the additional double down wager may be any amount up to the total amount already in play for the hand.

INSURANCE

Whenever the first card dealt to the dealer is an Ace, you have the right to make an "insurance wager" which wins if the dealer's second card is a King, Queen, Jack or 10 and loses if the dealer's second card is an Ace, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 or 9. Up to half the initial wager may be bet as insurance after the second card is dealt and prior to any additional cards being dealt. Winning "insurance wagers" shall be paid to odds of 2 to 1.

PLAYER ACE

If your initial starting card is an Ace, you will only receive one card whether you hit or double.

BLACKJACK

If you double down and receive a blackjack, you will receive the posted blackjack odds for both the main wager and double down amount.

PLAYER HAND	ODDS
Any Blackjack	3 to 2

PUSH 22

If the dealer busts with a point total of 22, any bets you have left in action are pushes. The PUSH 22 side bet wins if the dealer busts with a point total of 22. If the dealer's final point total is any number other than 22, the PUSH 22 side bet loses.

Note: Player blackjacks are paid before the dealer hits out their hand, so they are exempt from the PUSH 22 rule.

PUSH 22 WAGER	ODDS
Dealer Suited 22	50 to 1
Dealer Colored 22	20 to 1
Dealer 22	7 to 1
